WHAT HAPPENS DURING THE COURSE

Students will complete one Open College Network West Midlands unit to receive the three credits towards their Level 2 Award In Progression.

They will work in the radio station gaining work experience in the radio production department, helping to edit and produce promos, podcasts and pre-recorded shows, which will be broadcast.

During the course the student will learn about radio production skills, including how to edit, use audio equipment and understand appropriate health and safety measures and professional working methods.

They will develop excellent IT and multi-media skills.

The student will also attend discipleship and Reflective Journal sessions.
