They will work in the Editorial Department gaining work experience in researching and writing music news stories, reviewing albums and conducting interviews. Some of their material will be published on the Cross Rhythms website. Their work experience will be compatible with their accreditation.

They will develop communication and journalistic skills.

The student will attend weekly discipleship and Reflective Journal sessions.
