Course Title:	Radio Production and Broadcasting
Leading To:	Open College Network West Midlands Level 3 accredited course
Duration:	Four month course (Monday-Friday 9am-5pm)

A course for aspiring 'Media Missionaries': to understand different forms of radio broadcasting (mainstream and Christian), production skills and to create various forms of radio production in a live broadcasting environment that takes a Christian worldview to the marketplace.

WHAT HAPPENS DURING THE COURSE

Students will complete five Open College Network West Midlands units to achieve their Open College Network West Midlands Level 3 accredited course.

They will work in the radio department gaining work experience in radio production and presenting. Their work experience will be compatible with their qualification.

During the course the student will conduct an interview in a studio and on-location; research and produce a magazine programme and a discussion programme on a given topic and research and develop radio production skills.

The student will also attend weekly discipleship and Reflective Journal sessions.
